

Zuidasdok in full swing July – August 2025



Zuidasdok is one of the largest infrastructural projects in the Netherlands. The project aims to improve the accessibility of Amsterdam and the northern part of the Randstad, both by road and by public transport.

Zuidasdok is a collaboration between Rijkswaterstaat, ProRail and the City of Amsterdam.

Throughout 2025, Zuidasdok will be working flat-out on the widening of the A10 Zuid and the redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station. This causes a lot of inconvenience for road users and train passengers.

- **23 June – 4 July**

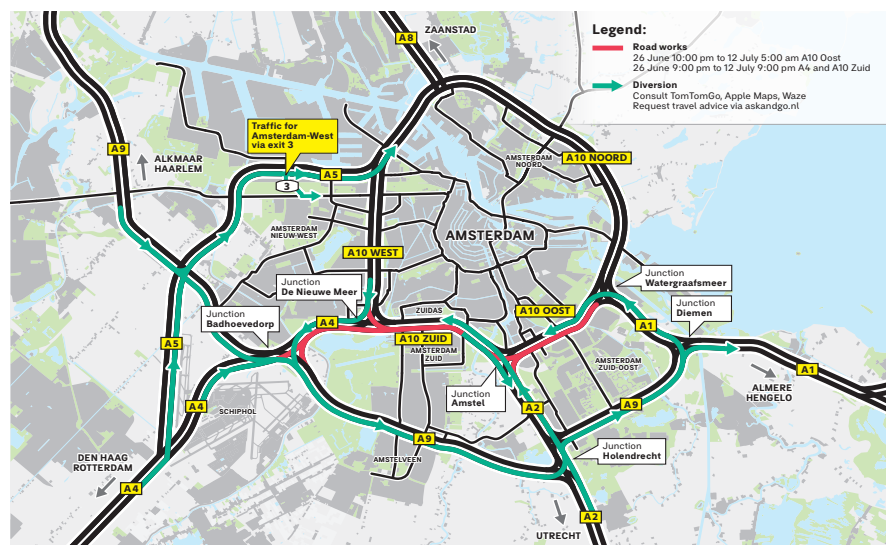
- **Parnassusweg closed (city-bound)**

- Parnassusweg will be closed for motorised traffic between Mahlerlaan and Strawinskylaan. From 30 June to 4 July, the closure also applies overnight.

- **26 June 9:00 pm – 12 July 9:00 pm**

- **Closure of A4, A10 Zuid and A10 Oost**

- The A4, A10 Zuid and A10 Oost in the direction A1 Hengelo and A2 Utrecht will be closed between junctions Badhoevedorp and Watergraafsmeer.



- **27 June – 15 August**

- Reduced train and metro services to and from Amsterdam Zuid station**

- There will be fewer trains and/or metros on several days in this period.

- Metro access from Zuidplein and train access from Mahlerplein will be closed at times.

- **11 July – 20 August**

- Amstelveenseweg closed at A10 Zuid for motorised traffic**

- City-bound traffic via A10 Zuid, then via S109.

- Traffic in direction Amstelveen via A4, then via exit 1 Sloten.

- Buses, cyclists and pedestrians can use Amstelveenseweg, with the following exception:

- Between 11 and 19 July, cyclists will be rerouted via Piet Kranenbergpad.

- The S108 access and exit routes will remain open.

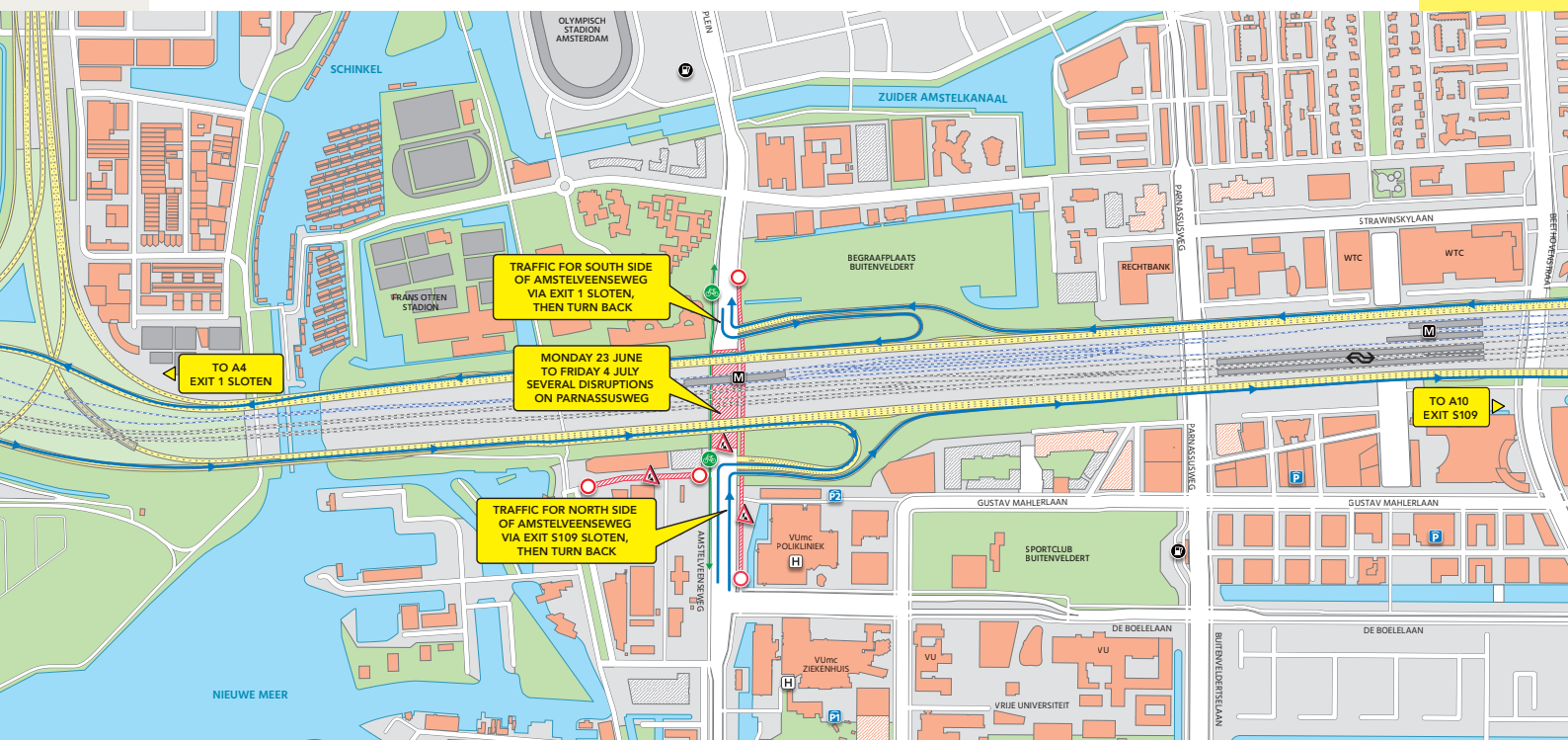
- The metro stop can only be reached via the west side of Amstelveenseweg.

- Tram 24 will not run between Stadionplein and De Boelelaan from 12 to 19 July.

- **19 July – 18 August**

- Parnassusweg closed (city-bound)**

- Parnassusweg will be closed between Mahlerlaan and Strawinskylaan. Diversion via De Boelelaan and Beethovenstraat. (info: 020-5273700, info@vervoerregio.nl)
