

Zuidasdok is redeveloping Amsterdam Zuid station. Trains, metros, trams and buses will all be operated from the same place. The station will boast an additional passageway for passengers and we are making the existing passageway both higher and wider. Over the summer, we will be working on the metro tracks at four locations between Parnassusweg and Beethovenstraat. People who live or work in the vicinity of the station, or who use the roads, metros or trains, will experience some inconvenience because of this.

Between Saturday 6 July and Monday 26 August 2024, we will be working at Amsterdam Zuid station, on the track used by metro lines 50 and 51 in the direction of Isolatorweg. We will elevate the track where it goes through the station and on Beethovenstraat. A new metro viaduct will be constructed across Parnassusweg. Two roof components for both the existing and the new station passageways will be pushed into place as well. These activities will cause inconveniences: (road) closures and noise..

Please note: there will be other weekend closures on the A10 Zuid (and the A4). Zuidasdok is also working on the reconstruction of the De Nieuwe Meer motorway junction. Stay up to date via Zuidasdok.nl and social media.

#### **Adjusted Metro timetable**

Between Saturday 6 July and Monday 26 August, the platform for metro lines 50 and 51 in the direction of Isolatorweg will be closed. These metro lines will still be operated throughout this period, although from a different platform and via a modified route. In addition, there will be only 6 departures per hour in each direction during the day, instead of the usual 12.

# Adjusted timetable for tram[s]

Between Friday 12 July 1:00 am and Monday 15 July 5:00 am, no trams will run between Parnassusweg and Strawinskylaan. Tram 5 will run up to Strawinskylaan from Zoutkeetsgracht, tram 25 will run up to the tram stop Parnassusweg (on the south side of the A10). Check your journey at GVB.nl.

## No access to station from Zuidplein (WTC)

From Thursday 11 July 11:00 pm to Friday morning 12 July 5:00 am and on Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 August, the existing station entrance will be closed on the side of Zuidplein (WTC). There will be a diversion via Parnassweg to Gustav Mahlerplein, where station access will still be possible. The station entrance and exit for train passengers on Parnassusweg will also remain open. If the overnight building works overrun, then there may be short traffic blockages near the metro entrance to allow cranes to operate safely. The waiting time for passengers would be about 10 minutes at most. The station entrance on the side of Mahlerplein will remain open.

#### **Closures on Parnassusweg**

Between Friday 12 July 23:59 pm to Friday 19 July 6:00 am, there will be road closures on Parnassusweg for all forms of traffic. The closures for pedestrians, cyclists, cars and public transport will vary in dates and time of day. Between 31 July 6:00 pm to 26 August 5:00 am there will be several closures for cyclists and cars during the evenings and overnight. The times and directions of these closures will also vary. Diversion routes will be signposted. Check the closures on Parnassusweg.

#### **Noise pollution**

The various construction activities on the metro tracks generate a lot of noise. During this period, building works can be expected for 24 hours per day. The intensity of the noise depends on the time of day, as the noisest activities will be carried out during the day. However, work will continue through the night.

During the day: On weekdays from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, on Saturdays from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm and on Sundays from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm.

Most of the noisy activities will be carried out between Saturday 6 July and Tuesday 23 July. The overview below lists the activities by location:

#### Overruns possible up to 9:00 pm

Work on dam walls that involves vibration, and hydrodemolition, will in principle be carried out during the day; however, work will continue up to 9:00 pm on Saturday, to enable a late start on Sunday. On a number of other days, work may also continue up to 9:00 pm, in the case of unforeseen overruns. This specifically relates to Sunday 7 July, Sunday 14 July, Monday 15 July and Thursday 18 up to Monday 22 July.

Overnight: from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am, or 9:00 am on Sundays

No loud noises will be generated during the nights. However, work will carry on. The combined noise of several machines will be audible. The noise will be of a monotonous nature. This kind of overnight noise is also expected to occur mostly during the month of July.
