Subject: **Disruptions due to building activities and Information Meeting 31 March**

Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

Throughout 2026, Zuidasdok will be working intensively on the widening of the A10 Zuid and the redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station. This is clearly good news for the future accessibility of the wider region, but in the short-term, there will be some inconvenience to endure. On the back of this letter, you will find an overview of the anticipated disruptions up to May 2026.

Construction activities around De Nieuwe Meer junction

The A10 Zuid is being widened by the addition of two traffic lanes in each direction. To accommodate this, building consortium TriAX is constructing a new fly-over and new bridges across the Schinkel river. The construction activities necessitate road closures on the A10 for fifteen weekends over the course of this year. During the summer holidays, Amstelveenseweg will again be closed for six weeks at the A10 viaduct, to enable the construction of new viaducts. In addition, we will insert 500 piles into the ground and will work on dam walls in this area. Unfortunately, this will generate considerable noise pollution.

Information meeting and guided tour

During an information meeting on 31 March, we will show a presentation informing you about the activities and clarifying the implications for you personally. Our team will be there to welcome you in Het Witte Huis (near the tennis courts), 45 IJsbaanpad, 1076 CV, Amsterdam. You do not need to register in advance. The same information meeting will be scheduled twice:

- 12:00 noon – 1:30 pm; the presentation starts at 12:15 pm.
- 5:30 – 7:00 pm; the presentation starts at 5:45 pm.

Construction activities at Amsterdam Zuid station

Building consortium Nieuw Zuid is finalising the construction of the new passageway at Amsterdam Zuid station and is, at the same time, also renovating the existing passageway. Over the next few months, we will remove the roofs over the train platforms, build new metro platforms and construct part of the roof over the future tunnel for cyclists and pedestrians near Antonio Vivaldistraat. This necessitates several closures of the A10 in its entirety, of individual traffic lanes and of train tracks. When the trains aren't running, the station can still be reached by metro, tram and bus.
