Onderwerp: Extreme traffic disruptions due to building works


Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

Major building works will be carried out near the De Nieuwe Meer motorway junction and Amsterdam Zuid station this summer. In this letter, we will inform you about these activities, and how they may affect you. The building works are part of Zuidasdok, which includes the widening and tunnelling of the A10 Zuid and the complete redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station.

## 26 June 9:00 pm - 12 July 9:00 pm: Extreme traffic disruption for 16 days

For a 16-day period, there will be road closures on the A4, A10 Zuid and A10 Oost in the direction A1 Hengelo / A2 Utrecht. Through traffic will be rerouted via the A9, A2 and A1. These alternative routes will be signposted via yellow road signs and the digital information panels suspended above the motorway. Travel times may be up to 60 minutes longer than normal.

Scope of building works We will be working 24 hours per day during this period. We will be making the entrance to Amsterdam Zuid station accessible to out-sized building materials. The A10 Zuid will be partially broken up to do this. At the De Nieuwe Meer junction, we will work on the support pillars for a flyover lane in the direction Schiphol/Rotterdam, which will become



operational in 2028. Finally, Rijkswaterstaat will be carrying out major maintenance works on the A10 Oost, which includes the replacement of asphalt, crash barriers and expansion joints.

## Amsterdam Zuid station

During this period, fewer trains will be running to and from Amsterdam Zuid station. For parts of some days between 13 July and 4 August, it will be impossible to get from Mahlerplein to Zuidplein through the station. Train platforms can be reached from Mahlerplein and Parnassusweg, while the metro is accessible from Zuidplein. Diversions will be signposted, and transport will be provided for people with reduced mobility.

# 11 July – 20 August: Closure of Amstelveenseweg

From Friday evening 11 July (the start of the summer holiday) to Wednesday 20 August, we will close Amstelveenseweg for motorised traffic at the point where it crosses underneath the A10 Zuid. Cyclists and pedestrians will be able to use the western side of Amstelveenseweg. Traffic will be rerouted via the A10 Zuid

and A4 entrance and exit lanes. The S108 access and exit routes to and from Amsterdam Oud Zuid and Buitenveldert will remain in use. The viaduct at this location will then be prepared for the widening of the A10 Zuid. This work will be carried out over three consecutive summers, i.e. also in 2026 and 2027. From 11 to 18 July only, cyclists will be rerouted via Piet Kranenbergpad. The Amstelveenseweg metro station can only be reached from the western side during this period. Tram 24 will not run between Stadionplein and De Boelelaan from Saturday 12 July to Friday 18 July. Buses will operate normally.

#### Travel advice

If you visit the area by car during this period, then plan your travel in advance. Up-to-date travel information can be obtained via navigation systems like TomTomGo, Waze and Apple Maps. # Noise pollution in the immediate vicinity

The building works are likely to generate noise that will at times be audible in the areas around Amsterdam Zuid station and the De Nieuwe Meer junction. The nature of the activities means that this can unfortunately not be avoided. The activities that generate the most noise are due to be carried out during the day.

## More road works

Up to the end of October, a lot of road works will be carried out in and around Amsterdam. We would therefore like to bring to your attention some activities by Rijkswaterstaat and Vervoerregio (regional transport authority) that may also affect you.
