Dear neighbours,

This is the final letter you will receive from the Atrium building consortium. You live and/or work near the construction site for the underground car park and the two new towers at the Atrium Building on the corner of Strawinskylaan and Parnassusweg. We would like to inform you about the current state of affairs.

Car park and towers now complete

The underground car park has been completed and has been in use for some time now. Both towers have also been completed. In the coming months, we will only be finishing work on some remaining parts of the building including the facades on the ground floor of the existing tower. We do not expect this work to cause any inconvenience. Several tenants have already moved into the towers.

Bicycle path

The bicycle path that crosses the construction site (parallel to Parnassusweg) is currently still closed. The City is currently still working on this area and trees were planted in December. In the coming weeks, the City plans to start constructing the bicycle paths and pavements. Once this work is complete, the bicycle path will open again. The construction consortium will also perform some small-scale renovation work in and around Parnassusweg.

Looking back

We look back on a wonderful project, working in a very special location visible from the A10 South. Soon we will be bidding this Zuidas construction site a fond farewell. We would like to thank all of you for your patience and understanding.
