To the residents and business owners in the Amsterdam Zuid station area

Dear resident,

We would like to inform you about building works that will be carried out in and around Amsterdam Zuid station from 31 October. These works are part of Zuidasdok, which involves the widening and tunneling of the A10 Zuid and the complete redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station.

More information

We are organising walk-in consultation sessions at the Amsterdam Zuidas information centre. These will take place in the afternoon and evening of Tuesday 25 October. There, between 12:00 noon and 1:30 pm and 5:00 and 7:00 pm, you can ask us any questions you may have about the activities referred to in this letter.

Overnight activities Monday 31 October to Wednesday 2 November

During these two nights, we have to remove part of a sheet pile wall,
near to the stairs to the metro platforms. This will be done overnight
to ensure the safety of passengers. The first night is between Monday
31 October and Tuesday 1 November, the second night between
Tuesday 1 November and Wednesday 2 November. The activities will
take place between 1:00 and 5:00 am. The sheet piles have to be
removed by means of vibration, which may cause noise pollution.

Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 November

Between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm we will insert sheet piling into the ground between the train and metro tracks. This too will happen by means of vibration, due to the length of the piles. To limit the inconvenience, we will be pre-drilling the soil beforehand. In the case of unforeseen events, such as really bad weather or malfunctioning equipment, we will continue to work into the evening. Trains and metros will run according to a modified timetable.

Tuesday 8 November

From 7:00 am we will be pouring concrete for a new section of the roof for the Brittenpassage. This will take approximately 10 hours.

Subsequently, we will level the concrete surface while it sets, using a concrete polishing machine. In the autumn, we have to wait longer

before we can start polishing, which is why we have to do it at night. This work will take place on Arnold Schönberglaan.

Sunday 13 November to Saturday morning 26 November

During this period, Prorail will carry out construction activities on the railway network, in order to increase the capacity between Schiphol Airport and Amsterdam. <u>Up to Friday 25 November</u>, no trains at all will be operated to or from Amsterdam Zuidas station. Please plan your trip on OV9292 or the NS travel planner before you set off. Zuidasdok will also make good use of this traffic-free period. From 19 to 24 November we will be working day and night at two locations:

- 1. Brittenpassage; Saturday 19 November to Tuesday 22 November

 At the location where the new station passageway is going to be built, we will remove the train platform so that we can insert foundation piles for future stairs and escalators to the platform. We will also place a number of sheet piles by means of vibration. This will be done between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm on Sunday 20 November. Finally, we will reconstruct the platform.
- 2. Vivaldi; Saturday 19 November to Wednesday 23 November
 On the construction site east of the Beethovenstraat (near AFC) we will dismantle the train tracks and fill a number of foundation piles that are already in place with reinforced concrete. On 23 November we will rebuild the tracks.

Disturbance

The building works will result in disturbance in the form of vibration, noise, bright light on the construction site and dust. We do understand that this can be very inconvenient for you. The activities that are carried out overnight, like the removal of sheet piling by means of vibration, are particularly likely to create noise pollution.

During the weekend of 5 and 6 November, trains and metros will run according to a modified timetable. Between 13 and 25 November there will be no train traffic to or from Amsterdam Zuid station. Passengers will therefore experience longer travel times. Metro's will run normally. On 26 and 27 November trains will again run on a modified timetable. Please consult OV9292 or the NS travel planner before you set off.
