Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

On the first of November 2026, the Brittenpassage in Amsterdam Zuid station will open its gates, while at the same time, the Minervapassage will be closed for an extended period (to be renovated). This means that the stream of daily passengers will flow through the station and the surrounding area differently.

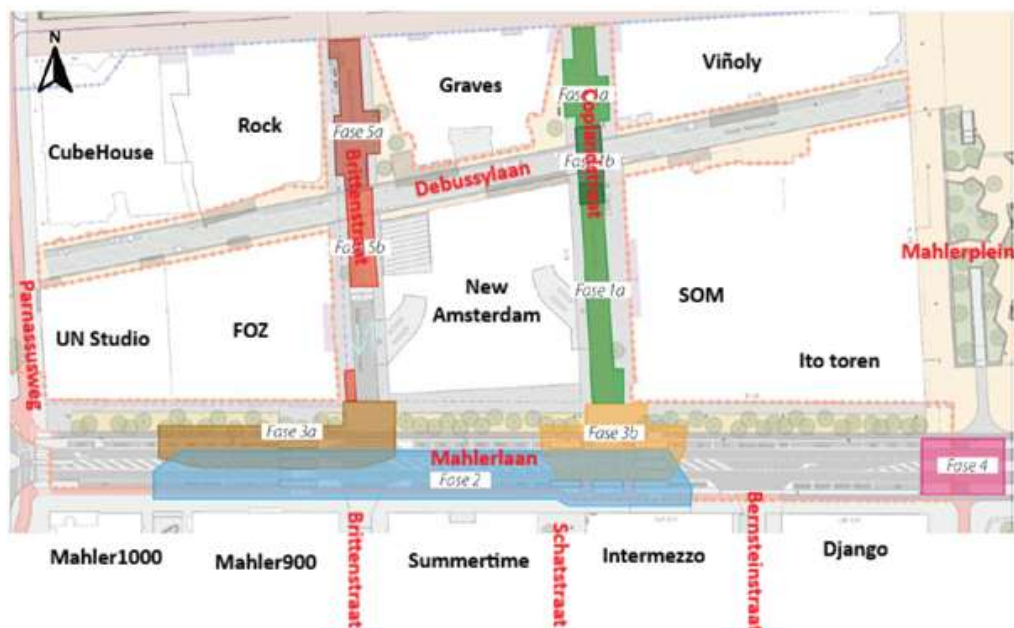
In order to prepare for these events, a set of measures has been conceived to guide passengers, office workers, residents and logistical traffic through the station area safely. For instance, motorized traffic will be restricted to timed windows, Coplandstraat will be dedicated as a cycling street and Brittenstraat will partly become a pedestrian zone. For more information about the measures and the traffic regime that will be taking effect from 1 November, visit Zuidas.nl. [QR Code].

The necessary modifications in the station area (to facilitate the new regime from 1 November) will be implemented between 17 August and 23 October, in a phased approach. On the reverse of this letter, you will find an overview of the phases, with a description of the impact of the construction activities for each phase. Please note: phase 2 commences before phase 1. All closures and deviations will naturally be signposted on-site and orchestrated by traffic controllers as well.

Phase 2: Monday 17 August to Friday 4 September

Construction of road crossing for cyclists and pedestrians, on the southern traffic lane on Mahlerlaan (between Mahler1000 and Bernsteinstraat).

Impact during this period:

- One-way traffic for motorized traffic on Mahlerlaan in west-to-east direction (from Parnassusweg to Beethovenstraat).
- Motorized traffic coming from Beethovenstraat can drive up to the construction site, where traffic controllers will direct them back in the direction of Beethovenstraat.
- Brittenstraat will be closed south of Mahlerlaan, but will remain accessible via Gershwinlaan.

Phase 1A: Saturday 22 August and Sunday 23 August

Application of red top layer on the road surface of Coplandstraat, to clearly indicate its status as a cycling street, where cyclists are given priority over car traffic. In addition, a camera will be placed on the intersection with Debussylaan; it will be switched on from 1 November.

Impact during this weekend:

- Coplandstraat inaccessible for motorized traffic and cyclists.
- Coplandstraat still accessible for pedestrians.

Phase 1B: Saturday 29 August and Sunday 30 August

Redevelopment of intersection of Coplandstraat and Debussylaan. The intersection will be re-paved in two stages, leaving one half of the street open for pedestrians and cyclists.

Impact during this weekend:

- Coplandstraat north of Debussylaan remains accessible for pedestrians and cyclists.
- For motorized traffic, Coplandstraat north of Debussylaan will only be accessible via Brittenstraat and Schönberglaan.
- Coplandstraat south of Debussylaan remains accessible for all traffic.

Phase 3A: Monday 7 September to Friday 18 September

Construction of pedestrian crossing on northern traffic lane of Mahlerlaan (near Brittenstraat).

Impact during this period:

- One-way traffic for motorized traffic on Mahlerlaan in east-to-west direction (from Beethovenstraat to Parnassusweg).
- Motorized traffic coming from Parnassusweg can drive up to the construction site, where traffic controllers will direct them back in the direction of Parnassusweg.
- Brittenstraat north of Mahlerlaan will be closed to motorized traffic coming from Mahlerlaan, but can be reached via Coplandstraat and Schönberglaan.

Phase 3B: Monday 21 September to Friday 2 October

Construction of road crossings on northern traffic lane of Mahlerlaan (near Coplandstraat).

Impact during this period:

- One-way traffic for motorized traffic on Mahlerlaan in east-to-west direction (from Beethovenstraat to Parnassusweg).
- Motorized traffic coming from Parnassusweg can drive up to the construction site, where traffic controllers will direct them back in the direction of Parnassusweg.
- Coplandstraat north of Mahlerlaan will be closed to motorized traffic coming from Mahlerlaan, but can be reached via Brittenstraat and Schönberglaan.

Phase 4: Saturday 3 October and Sunday 4 October

Improve road safety of road crossings for cyclists and pedestrians near Mahlerplein.

Impact during this weekend:

- Road will be closed at Mahlerplein for motorized traffic in both directions.
- Motorized traffic coming from Parnassusweg can drive up to the construction site, where traffic controllers will direct them back in the direction of Parnassusweg.
- Motorized traffic coming from Beethovenstraat can drive up to the construction site, where traffic controllers will direct them back in the direction of Beethovenstraat.

Phase 5A: Monday 5 October to Friday 16 October

Replacement of asphalt with clinkers on Brittenstraat, north of Debussylaan, to highlight the transition of this part of the street into a pedestrian zone (façade to façade). In addition, a camera will be placed on the intersection with Debussylaan; it will be switched on from 1 November.

Impact during this period:

- Brittenstraat north of Debussylaan will be closed to motorized traffic and cyclists. Pedestrians can keep using this part of Brittenstraat.
- Brittenstraat south of Debussylaan will remain accessible for all traffic.

Phase 5B: Monday 19 October to Friday 23 October

Redevelopment of intersection of Brittenstraat and Debussylaan. The intersection will be re-paved in two stages, leaving one half of the street open to pedestrians and cyclists. In addition, the road will be marked to direct one-way traffic, and a row of single bicycle racks will be removed.

Impact during this period:

- For motorized traffic, Brittenstraat north of Debussylaan will only be accessible via Coplandstraat and Schönberglaan.
- Brittenstraat south of Debussylaan remains accessible for all traffic.
