Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

We would like to invite you to an information market on Wednesday 12 February. During this meeting, we would like to bring you up to date on the latest developments and plans for the Amstel motorway junction. This is a great opportunity for you to learn more about it and ask any questions you may have.

Meeting details

During the information market, we will review the progress of the redevelopment, current plans and other important points with regards to the Amstel junction. Our team will be ready to welcome you on the sixth floor of the Van der Valk Hotel Amsterdam Zuidas, 200 Tommaso Albinonistraat, 1083 HM Amsterdam. You do not need to register in advance.

- Slot 1: 12 February from 12 noon to 1:00 pm
- Slot 2: 12 February from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm

What we will do at Amstel junction

We are going to ensure a smoother and safer flow of traffic on the A10 Zuid. The motorway will be widened and through traffic will be separated from local traffic. This will be achieved by putting in place parallel traffic lanes.

- We are building 23 new viaducts;
- We will construct new connecting lanes;
- The existing southernmost Rozenoord-bridge will be demolished and replaced;
- Two new Rozenburg-bridges will be added across the Amsel river;
- Noise barriers will be placed;
- The local road network will be modified in several places.

In addition, we will move the current bicycle lane on the southern Rozenoord-bridge to the additional bridge that will be built specifically to accommodate the parallel traffic lane. Ouderkerkerdijk will become a bicycle-priority street between the Amstel and the police academy. And finally, Europaboulevard will be modified so that it flows neatly into the new tunnel. In other words, plenty of work to get on with! The reconstruction of Amstel junction will take about nine years, and will commence in 2028.

Zuidasdok is a co-operation between Rijkswaterstaat, ProRail and the City of Amsterdam.

Zuidasdok is the largest infrastructural project in the Netherlands. The A10 Zuid will be widened between the junctions Nieuwe Meer and Amstel. Through traffic will be separated from local traffic, and the number of lanes will be increased from four to six in each direction. In the heart of the Zuidas district, the A10 will be routed through a tunnel. These innovations will improve the flow of traffic and thereby the accessibility of the northern Randstad, the surrounding region and the City of Amsterdam.
