Subject: Replanting of Strawinskypad embankment

Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

Up to 7 March, we will be working on the embankment near Strawinskypad, between Beethovenstraat and Amaliaplein. As the Strawinskyhuis building is now in use and Strawinskypad has been re-paved, our next job is to complete the layout of the embankment by planting new trees and plants. The trees will be placed in a loosely scattered pattern, aiming for a natural feel. The plants will be specially chosen to ensure that there will be flowers throughout the year. They will also be selected for their ability to thrive in dry and shady conditions. The layout of this part of the embankment will merge neatly into the planting of the embankment between Parnassusweg and Amaliaplein.

Planning

We have already begun clearing the embankment and removing dead shrubs and loose branches. On 17 and 18 February, a few trees, which are currently situated near the GVB-shelter on Strawinskylaan, will be relocated to the embankment near Strawinskypad. We are doing this because the GVB-shelter will be renovated at the end of the year, and the trees would have had to be removed anyway to make place for the new building. A permit for the relocation of these trees has already been issued. Between 19 February and 7 March 2025, the new trees and plants will be planted on the embankment.

Accessibility

Cyclists and pedestrians will be guided past the activities by traffic controllers. It will only be necessary to close Strawinskypad completely during the relocation of the trees from Strawinskylaan – on 17 and 18 February – due to the deployment of heavy machinery. At that time, cyclists and pedestrians will be rerouted via Prinses Irenestraat.
