Onderwerp: Building works Prinses Irenestraat 5 – 17 juni

Dear resident,

Building works will be carried out on Prinses Irenestraat between 5 and 17 June. During these two weeks, we will be digging exploratory trenches at several locations, to carry out soil surveys and chart the location of cables and pipes. This is a necessary preparation for the refurbishment of this street, which is planned for the second half of 2024. In this letter, we inform you about the upcoming activities, and how they may affect you.

Exploratory trenches

The exploratory trenches will be dug on 18 locations on Prinses Irenestraat. These trenches will run across the entire width of the street and be approximately a meter and a half deep. Two trenches will be dug each day. In the morning, the road surface will be removed from the entire width of the street at the location of the trench. The trench will then be dug, and subsequently, the underground situation will be investigated and documented. At the end of the afternoon, the trench will be filled in again and the road surface replaced.

Locations, planning and inconvenience

As the exploratory trenches will be dug across the entire width of Prinses Irenestraat, motorised traffic will be diverted via streets in the surrounding area. The locations of the trenches will vary day by day, which means the diversions will also change daily. These diversions will be locally signposted. In addition, traffic controllers will be present to ensure everything runs smoothly and safely. Pedestrians and cyclists will still be able to make their way past the trenches. Electric pumps will be deployed to remove groundwater from the exploratory trenches. This may cause some noise pollution in the immediate vicinity.
