We would like to inform you of building works in your neighbourhood that may cause you some inconvenience. These works are part of Zuidasdok, which involves the widening and tunneling of the A10 Zuid and the complete redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station.

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#### **Pouring concrete in Minervapassage**

On one evening towards the end of March or the beginning of April, we will be pouring concrete for the floor of the temporary GVB Ticket & Service Desk. We will start early in the evening, so as to minimize the need to work late into the night. The exact date for this will be published on our website.

#### **First weekend in April: insertion and removal of sheet piling**

On Saturday 1 April, between 7:00 am and 9:00 pm, and on Sunday 2 April between 9:00 am and 7:00 pm, we will insert a soldier piled wall into the ground at the construction site between the metro tracks near Amsterdam Zuid station. This will be done by means of vibration. A soldier piled wall is a dam wall constructed of steel H-piles and sheets. The H-piles can only be inserted by means of vibration. For the sake of passenger safety, we will close off the staircase to one metro platform (3) during these activities. All metro platforms will be accessible at platform level. Closing off this staircase is only possible during weekends.

#### **Mid April: pouring concrete for one day and building works in the evening**

During the week of 12 April we will be pouring concrete for the fifth roof section on our construction site on Arnold Schönberglaan, south of the A10. These activities will take place between 6:00 am and 11:00 pm. After it is poured, a concrete polishing machine will be used to level the surface. We will slide this fifth roof section into its place underneath the A10 and the train tracks sometime this summer, along with another section, which was created earlier and now lies next to the A10.

**Inconvenience**

The building works cannot be carried out without causing some inconvenience and we do realise that this can be a nuisance to you. We will do all we can to complete the works as quickly and safely as possible. The pouring of concrete in the Minervapassage will take place in the evening, when fewer passengers will be using the station. In the background, you may hear the concrete pump located on the building site between the metro tracks.

The insertion of the soldier piled wall will cause some nuisance because of vibration and noise, but the insertion of these steel H-piles generates less noise than the installation of sheet piles.

On the day that the concrete for the fifth roof section will be poured, the building site will be accessed via Parnassusweg by increased amount of construction traffic (120 trucks). To ensure a safe crossing at the foot- and cycle path on Parnassusweg, traffic controllers will close the cycle path for one to two minutes at a time. For your own safety, please follow the instructions of the traffic controllers. We kindly ask you for your understanding and patience during these activities.
