Onderwerp: Building works during the summer: Saturday 6 July to Monday morning 26 August 2024

Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

We would like to inform you about the building works related to the redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station and the construction of an additional station passageway: the Brittenpassage. These activities are part of Zuidasdok, which involves the widening and tunneling of the A10 Zuid, and the complete redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station.

Building works during the summer: elevation of metro track and platform and installation of roof components for Minervapassage

From Saturday 6 July to Monday morning 26 August 2024, we will be working on the redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station. One of the things we will do is to make the existing station passageway, the Minervapassage, both wider and higher. We will be working on metro track 2 at four locations between Parnassusweg and Beethovenstraat, in order to elevate the track (including the platform); this track is used by metro lines 50 and 51 (in the direction of Isolatorweg). On Parnassusweg, we will work on the metro viaduct. For both the existing and the new passageway, we will push a new roof component into its permanent position. On Beethovenstraat we will elevate the existing viaduct. Walk in meetings have been planned on 24 and 25 June, in the Zuidas-Zuidasdok Information Centre, where you can ask us any questions you may have.

Work relating to dam walls

When? Between Saturday 6 July and Tuesday 23 July 2024

Where? Amsterdam Zuid station Measures to limit noise pollution

Both the insertion of dam walls, by means of vibration, and their extraction will be planned to take place during the day. However, we are permitted to work until 9:00 pm in case the building works overrun. We will implement noise-reducing measures as far as we can. For example, we will soften the soil in advance by injecting water under very high pressure (fluidization). This makes it easier to insert the dam walls. We will also insulate the sources of noise as much as possible.

- Saturday 6 to Monday 15 July: daily activities to insert and remove dam walls
- Thursday 18 to Tuesday 23 July: daily activities to insert and remove dam walls

Demolition activities on metro track and platform

When? From Saturday 6 July to Tuesday 23 July 2024

Where? Parnassusweg, Minervapassage and Beethovenstraat

Measures to limit noise pollution

All activities are planned to take place during the day, but we are permitted to operate our hydrodemolition* equipment until 9:00 pm in case of overruns. The sources of noise will be insulated as much as possible.

- Saturday 6 to Sunday 21 July
 - Parnassusweg: demolition works, involving sawing and hydrodemolition, crushing and hammering
- Saturday 6 July to Sunday 14 July
 - Minervapassage: demolition of deck and platform
- Monday 15 July to Tuesday 23 July

• Beethovenstraat: bush hammering** of abutments and support points

*Hydrodemolition is a technique to remove concrete from the reinforcement cages in the decks supporting the tracks using powerful water jets (up to 3,000 bar). This eliminates the need for vibration, avoids the release of dust and leaves the reinforcement cage intact.

****Bush hammering** is a technique to roughen a concrete surface with special (bush) hammers. Afterwards, rollers made of tempered steel are used to even out the surface.

Adjusted timetable metro 50 and 51

Saturday 6 July 1:00 am – Sunday 7 July 5:00 am: no metros between metro station Amstelveenseweg and Amsterdam Zuid station

Shuttle bus 71 will run between Amsterdam Zuid station (bus stop A) and metro station Amstelveenseweg. Metro 50 runs between Amsterdam Zuid station and Gaasperplas; metro 51 runs between Amstelveenseweg and Isolatorweg.

Sunday 7 July 5:00 am – Monday 26 August 5:00 am: adjusted timetable metro line 50 (Isolatorweg) and 51 (Gaasperplas)

To operate as many metros as possible, the lines are 'cut' at Amsterdam Zuid station:

- Metro line 50 will run between Amsterdam Zuid station and metro station Gaasperplas (platform 3).
- Metro line 51 will run between metros station Isolatorweg and Amsterdam Zuid station (platform 1).
- Metro line 52 (Noord/Zuidlijn) will operate according to the normal timetable during the entire period.

Closures of A10 Zuid

Friday 28 June 10:00 pm - Monday 1 July 5:00 am

The A10 Zuid will be closed in the direction A1 Hengelo/A2 Utrecht up to exit S108 Amsterdam Oud Zuid/ Buitenveldert. Alternative routing via A2 and A9 or A10 Noord and A5.

During the evenings and nights from Tuesday 6 to Friday 9 August, the A10 Zuid is closed in the direction of A4 Schiphol/Rotterdam between 10:00 pm and 5:00 am.

Closure of station passageway

Thursday 11 July 11:00 pm - Friday 12 July 5:00 am

The station passageway will be closed on the side of Zuidplein (WTC). Trains and metros will still be accessible via Mahlerplein, and access to trains will also still be possible via the stairs on Parnassusweg.

Possible disruption on Saturday morning 13 July and Sunday morning 14 July

During this weekend, heavy materials will be hoisted over the top of the passageway. This will take place overnight. However, if this work runs over, we may have to continue during the day. In that case, we will keep passengers out of the metro area, for their own safety, while the cranes are in operation. Waiting times would be about 10 minutes at most. Would you prefer not to wait? A diversion route to Gustav Mahlerplein will be signposted via Beethovenlaan; the station entrance on Gustav Mahlerplein will remain open and access to trains and metros will be uninterrupted on this side of the station.

Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 August

The station entrance on Zuidplein will be closed. A diversion route to Gustav Mahlerplein will be signposted via Parnassusweg. The entrance on this side of the station will remain open. For train passengers, the entrance and exit on Parnassusweg will also remain in use. From this exit, a walking route in the direction of the city centre will be signposted.



Additional transport between Zuidplein and Gustav Mahlerplein

Taxi buses will be available on Matthijs Vermeulenpad (WTC/Zuidplein) and on Arnold Schönberglaan (Mahlerplein) to transport people with restricted mobility from Zuidplein (WTC) to Gustav Mahlerplein and vice versa. These vans will be available on:

- Thursday 11 July: from 10:00 pm to 1:00 am
- Saturday 10 August: from 5:30 am to 1:00 am
- Sunday 11 August: from 5:30 am to 1:00 am
