Subject: **Replacement of gravel on Europaplein-Oost**

Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

After the newly laid-out Europaplein-Oost was delivered in December 2022, several other (minor) modifications were implemented on and around the square. For example, more greenery was planted and additional bicycle racks were placed. The final modification is planned for the end of October, which we would like to inform you about in this letter.

Replacement of surface layer of the footpath

On Europaplein-Oost, the footpath was finished with a surface layer of coarse gravel, a so-called semi-paved surface. This top layer of the path will be replaced by a different gravel mixture during the week of 30 October to 3 November. This is necessary because it turned out that the type of gravel currently used has an adverse impact on the lawnmowers. As people walk on the footpath, small amounts of the gravel spread from the path into the edges of the lawn. When the grass is cut, this gravel ends up in the lawnmowers, which were not designed to cope with this. This problem can be avoided by using a finer type of gravel. Gravel with a finer structure can safely pass through the mower blades. In terms of appearance, the new surface layer will not be very different from the current one, it just has a slightly finer structure.

Activities

The activities will take place between Monday 30 October and Friday 3 November. This means that the square will not be accessible to residents during this week. Six parking places will also be suspended during this time, because the contractor needs the space to store materials, amongst other things. The affected parking spaces are located in front of house numbers 111 to 119.

The activities will take place between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm, and may at times be audible in the immediate vicinity. Otherwise, the activities will not result in any major inconvenience.
