Subject: **Building works June – July 2026**

Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

We would like to inform you about the building works we will carry out from 1 June around around the outer ring road between the Schinkel Bridge and Amstelveenseweg. These activities are part of Zuidasdok, which includes the widening and tunnelling of the A10 Zuid and the complete redevelopment of Amsterdam Zuid station.

512 piles

For these works, it has been decided to install the piles using pile-driving methods. This means that the works can be completed within a relatively short period, but it also means that you may experience increased noise disturbance in the immediate vicinity. We understand that this may cause inconvenience. To keep the duration of the works as short as possible, we will be using two piling rigs operating simultaneously.

What will happen?

- Driving 512 piles into the ground (to a depth of approximately 19 metres)
- Location: between the Schinkel Bridge and Amstelveenseweg, alongside the motorway

When will it happen?

- Monday 1 June – Friday 31 July
- Weekend works: Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 June
- Workingtime: 7:00 am – 19.00 pm

Why is this necessary?

The piles form the foundation for the future widening of the A10 Zuid at the De Nieuwe Meer junction. The piles will be installed to a depth of 19 metres. These are the final 512 piles required for the pile mattress, bringing the total number of installed piles to 3.500. Once the piles have been installed, pile caps will be placed on top, followed by several layers of geotextile and sand. This will create a stable foundation for the new carriageways of the A10 Zuid. In the future there will be four regular lanes and an emergency lane: two lanes for through traffic and two for local destinations. The redevelopment of De Nieuwe Meer junction will be completed around 2031.
