Subject: **Overview June – August 2026**

Dear resident, business owner or other interested party,

This summer, Zuidasdok and Zuidas will be carrying out construction works at several locations along the A10 Zuid, as well as in Zuidas. We will work on the motorway, viaducts, metro infrastructure and public space, to assure the future accessibility of Amsterdam and the surrounding region.

The works will unfortunately cause some inconvenience. In this letter, we will inform you about the main activities and traffic disruptions, so that you won't be caught out. In addition, we will try to minimize the inconvenience, by co-ordinating activities in the same area so that road closures can be kept to a minimum.

How will this affect you?

- Noise and vibrations: during the pile-driving activities in June and July, you may experience noise pollution and notice vibrations in the vicinity of the A10 Zuid.
- Additional traffic volumes and diversions: the closure of roads and underpasses will increase the risk of congestion in Amsterdam Zuid and on the A10 ring road. Yellow signs will be placed to divert traffic.
- Overnight construction activities: on some days we will continue working into the night, if that is required to execute the work safely. If Amstelveenseweg is closed overnight because of this, then Amstelveenseweg metro station will be closed temporarily too.

On the reverse of this letter, you will see the exact location of our activities.

Saturday 20 June – National Construction Day

During the National Construction Day on 20 June, building consortium TriAX will be inaugurating part of the construction site for Schinkel-bridge and the new fly-over lane. You are very welcome to drop by. The site on 61 Jaagpad will be open from 10 am to 4 pm.

Visitors will be able to get a close-up view of the current Schinkel-bridge, and also the two new bridges. Several construction vehicles will be there for inspection, and you can also take a stroll on the new fly-over lane. Fun activities will be organised for children, so we hope you will come and find out what the project looks like from up-close! Do not forget to wear sturdy shoes.

Zuidasdok improves the accessibility of Amsterdam and the northern Randstad region. It involves widening the A10 Zuid and constructing tunnels for it, as well as completely redeveloping Amsterdam Zuid station.

Period	Building works	Inconvenience/implications
1 June – 31 July	Pile-driving between Schinkel-bridge and Amstelveenseweg for widening of A10 Zuid.	Possibly some noise and vibrations. On working days from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. And also on Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 June.
12 June 10:00 pm – 15 June 5:00 am	A10 Zuid closed in direction A4 and A10 West, from access route S108; to accommodate heavy lifting for new Schinkel-bridge	Connections from A10 Noord → A10 Oost and from A10 Oost → A10 Zuid will be closed too. Allow 30-60 minutes additional travel time.
13 June 7:00 am – 5:00 pm	Pile-driving for the foundation for sound barriers and portals.	Noise and vibrations may be experienced on the north side of A10 Zuid, near Frans Otten stadium.
18 June – 3 July	East side of Parnassusweg (direction city centre) closed for all traffic, to facilitate work on the new metro viaduct.	Pedestrians and cyclists will use the path on the opposite side. Cars will be diverted.
26 June 10:00 pm – 29 June 05:00 am	Closure of A4 (coming from Schiphol Airport and Amstelveen) and A10 Zuid up to exit S108, to accommodate heavy lifting for new Schinkel-bridge.	A10 West in direction A10 Zuid will be closed too. Diversion: A9/A5 or A10 Oost. Allow 30-60 minutes additional travel time.
3 July 7:00 pm – 17 August 5:00 am	A10 Zuid underpass on Amstelveenseweg closed, to allow for construction of new viaducts over the widened A10 Zuid.	Diversions for cars. Foot- and cycle paths on west side remain open.
Nights of 6, 7 and 8 July (9 July reserve date)	Overnight building works on Amstelveenseweg.	A10 Zuid underpass on Amstelveenseweg closed completely for all traffic. Amstelveenseweg metro station closed.
Nights of 6 and 7 July	Removal of 5 trees on Amstelveenseweg, near Tripolis Park, to make space for a new bus stop and enable redesign of intersection.	Trees will be checked in advance, for birds' nests and other animals, by an ecologist.
Mid-July – approx. 5 weeks	Modifications to bicycle crossing on Fred. Roeskestraat.	Outgoing traffic will be diverted via Parnassusweg and Olympiaplein/Stadionplein.
24 – 28 August	East side of Parnassusweg (towards city centre) closed for cars, due to work on the metro viaduct.	Diversions and possible delays.
